Ron's Report:

All sports are outside except girls volleyball and gymnastics. Girls volleyball were silver bracket champions last weekend.

Website: Click on teams for family id, nurses forms and team schedules

Family ID: Please have families register, open for all sports (fall, winter, spring)

If a fall athlete, if someone on team is exposed to covid, the families will be notified.

Membership Report: Lori – Membership through August 2021 was at 109 athletes (91 families) vs. only 79 athletes through August in 2020. 69 football families registered in August. The transition to register on the website is very helpful to track memberships and data.

Treasurer's report: Alla: There are a couple of negative balances which need to be covered. Alla is uploading the financials onto the website in the Treasurers section. The expense submissions are now automated in the form section. The form will automatically go to Ron Anello and the coach. The deposit form is on the website to print, fill out and provide to Alla. In terms of financial activity, it was minimal. The biggest expense was Huddle (\$800/team that uses Huddle).

New business: Concessions – football has their system of running concessions. Other teams can run concessions as well. Agreement is if your team uses concessions, Boosters will give the team \$100. If you go over \$100, Boosters will take 30% out of the additional amount over \$100 (to cover the cost of food/drinks) and the team keeps the rest of the money. Teams can do concessions wherever it is convenient (at the field, gym, etc.). Alla has the cash box for all sports besides football. Coordinate getting cash box with Alla ahead of time. At the end of the game, make sure trash is thrown away and refrigerators are stocked up when before you leave. Help can be provided to show you how to make certain things at the concession stand. Call Derek for assistance with the concession stand and Alla for assistance with the cash box.

Derek will send an email regarding the Lions Club Franklin Lakes Carnival at McBride field where student athletes can volunteer for 2-3 hour shifts on 9/25 and 9/26. If any kids want to volunteer, send their names/contact info to Derek and then times will be assigned. For the Lions Club Christmas Tree sales, kids can get volunteer hours and the Lions Club will make a contribution to Boosters.

Derek will be at the concession stand Tuesday, 9/14 from 3-4pm to distribute membership t-shirts for families that signed up for the membership as of Friday, 9/10 and web orders. A student designed the membership t-shirt this year.

Boosters is considering a holiday ornament and mug fundraiser (\$15/each). For every one sold, Boosters get \$5 back. Minimum of 25 sold. People can pay online. Yeti water bottles are a possibility for \$25/each. Derek will contact a volunteer to oversee this fundraiser.

We do not have a Vice President. Derek will put together a job description for this role.

We have an app for the boosters rep's and then one for all of the members with important information. Stories and articles can be communicated through the app. Information such as Athlete of the Week or a big win can be posted to the app. Send content to Derek and he can post it to the community.
