Mike's Report:

Boys Basketball is currently 10-0 and ranked # 8 in NJ with a recent win over #5 Ranked Bergen Catholic. Junior Peyton Seals was named Athlete of the week by North Jersey .com

Bowling is doing well with the Girls record at 3-2 and the Boys at 3-3.

Boys Fencing is 3-0 and recently finished second in the Bergen County Tournament.

Treasurer's report (Alla):

Updates/New business:
