Ramapo Athletics Spring Season Wrap Up

Baseball: The baseball team finished with a 16-12 record. They advanced to the Semi Finals of the NJSIAA Tournament, but lost a tough game to Morris Knolls 5-2.

Boys Golf: The boys golf team finished with a 17-3 record. They won the NJSIAA State Sectional and Group 3 Championship as well as the prestigious Arcola Invitational.

Boys Lacrosse: The boys lacrosse team finished with a 9-10 record. They beat Tenafly in the first round of the NJSIAA State Tournament before losing a tough game to Ridge HS. The highlight of the year was defeating State Ranked Ridgewood 4-3 late in the season.

Boys Tennis: The boys tennis team finished with an 8-9 record. The team qualified for the NJSIAA Tournament and had 2 golfers, Max Loia and Matt Miller advance 2 rounds in the NJSIAA Singles Tournament.

Boys Volleyball: The boys volleyball team finished with a 16-6 record. They advanced to the Semi Finals of the NJSIAA Tournament with a 2-0 win over Nutley.

Flag Football: The flag football team had an outstanding season and qualified for the league playoffs. The team defeated Clifton in the first round before losing to the eventual champ Irvington.

Girls Golf: The girls golf team finished with a 4-2-1 record and qualified for the NJSIAA Team Tournament. They finished the season 3-1-1 in their last 5 matches.

Softball: The softball team finished with a 21-9 record. They advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Bergen County Tournament and the Semi Final Round of the NJSIAA State Tournament.

Girls Lacrosse: The girls lacrosse team finished 2-2 in their last 4 games. The team defeated Scotch Plains Fanwood High School in the opening round of the NJSIAA State Tournament before bowing to Chatham High School in a tough game in round 2.

Membership Report (Sonja) – Membership 371 athletes, 308 families. Sonja's replacement is Sue Perneti. Teams receive \$500 if have 100% membership compliance.

Treasurer's report (Alla):

Slower activity this month with less expenses than last month. Added a line item for teams raising money through SnapRaise or something similar. All teams are in the positive. Drew Gibbs Scholarship fund is in the financial sheet.

Updates/New business:
